The Rehabilitation Act of 1973 is a civil liberties law that forbids discrimination on the basis of disability by federally funded programs. Its sections address several important areas. Section 504 makes special education and other academic services available to students with disabilities, using a broader interpretation of "disability" than IDEA.
