Eviction Procedures and Instruction Sheet NOTICE: The landlord first must give proper written notice to the tenant: A. For non-payment of rent, a 5 day written notice must be given to the tenant first, unless there is a clause in the lease stating otherwise.

Eviction is a legal dispute between a landlord and tenant due to non-payment of monies owned (rent) for the residential property. Information on eviction can be located in Florida Statutes Chapter 83 Landlord actions.

County Civil - Broward County Clerk of Courts

Signed instructions directing the Sheriff to serve process or perform an enforcement action are required. The instructions must be signed by your attorney or by you, if you don't have an attorney. A Sheriff's Instructions form accompanies the Information Guide for each type of process or enforcement action.

Civil Process

The landlord/tenant relationship is controlled by the terms of your lease and by Part II of Chapter 83 of the Florida Statutes. The procedures for enforcing your rights under your lease and Part II of Chapter 83 ar e set forth in

Instructions to the Constable - Clark County, Nevada

An eviction by the Sheriff is the final step of a process that includes an unlawful detainer judgment for possession of property. The Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office performs evictions after a judgment for possession is obtained and a valid writ of possession, written instructions (see below), and proper fees are delivered to the Sheriff's Civil Division.

The Deputy Sheriff that is assigned the paperwork will contact the person listed on the instruction sheet to notify them that it has been posted and set a time and date to meet at the location to complete the eviction. At the time of eviction, you or your representative will need to meet the Deputy Sheriff to take physical control of the property.

After filing with the court, you will be handed an Instruction Sheet to fill out. You are to return to our office with the Instructions to the Constable cover sheet and pay our office for the lock-out. Notices expire after 30 days and will no longer be available for use on a particular eviction. What to expect after you file in Justice Court?

Generally, an eviction action summons and complaint must be served by a constable, sheriff or licensed process server, who must either personally serve the tenant or, post in an obvious place and then mail to the tenant by certified mail.
